Annual Renewal

Conduct and Attitude

It is expected that bursary recipients will have a positive attitude, be of good conduct and show loyalty to their school. Continued misdemeanors or gross violations of the school's Code of Conduct will place the bursary in jeopardy, and a decision to withdraw the bursary will be at the sole discretion of the school.

Cancellation of Bursary

Should the bursary recipient leave the school before the five years of High School have been completed, for any reason not mutually agreed upon, the parent/ guardian will be liable to repay the school the value of the bursary for the time that the student was at the school.
