Music Scholarship Process:

Suitable music scholarship candidates will be invited to an audition and music theory assessment.

Audition requirements:

- Three pieces of contrasting styles will need to be played to the selection panel.
- Three copies of the relevant music must be provided for the members of the panel.
- Should the applicant audition on more than one instrument, one piece must be played on the second instrument.
- The candidate will be tested on scales and sight reading at the level of the pieces played.
- The candidate will be required to complete an aural test.
- The candidate will complete a theory assessment.
- The candidate will be interviewed by the panel.
- Where required, the candidate should provide her own accompanist.

Scholarship Benefits:

- The scholarship provides a disbursement on academic tuition fees.
- The enrolment fee is aligned with the percentage disbursement offered in the scholarship.
- Uniforms, books, stationery, electronic devices, study requirements, extras, and levies are excluded from the disbursement.
- The full instrument tuition fee is payable.
- Fees for Eisteddfodau, external examinations and competitions are excluded.
- Instrument hire, if applicable, is excluded.
- Costs of tours are excluded.

Scholarship Obligations:

- To play an active role in the music life of the school (membership of choirs and/or ensembles).
- To take music as an elective subject in Grades 8 and 9.
- To take music as an FET subject from Grades 10 to 12.
- To attend all music functions and concerts.
- To maintain a high academic standard.

Conditions of Scholarships:

Annual Renewal

The intention of the school is to provide a scholarship for the full five years of High School. Scholarships are reviewed annually, and there is no automatic renewal of a scholarship. Should a student not continue to meet the requirements for scholarship, the scholarship may be reassigned.

Conduct and Attitude

It is expected that scholarship recipients will have a positive attitude, be of good conduct and show loyalty to their school. Continued misdemeanors or gross violations of the school's Code of Conduct will place the scholarship in jeopardy, and a decision to withdraw the scholarship will be at the sole discretion of the school.

Cancellation of Scholarship

Should the scholarship recipient leave the school before the five years of High School have been completed, for any reason not mutually agreed upon, the parent/guardian will be liable to repay the school the value of the scholarship for the time that the student was at the school.
